- *Healthcare and Social Assistance is the 2nd largest Industry in Solano County, Government is the Largest Industry with more than 32K employees.*

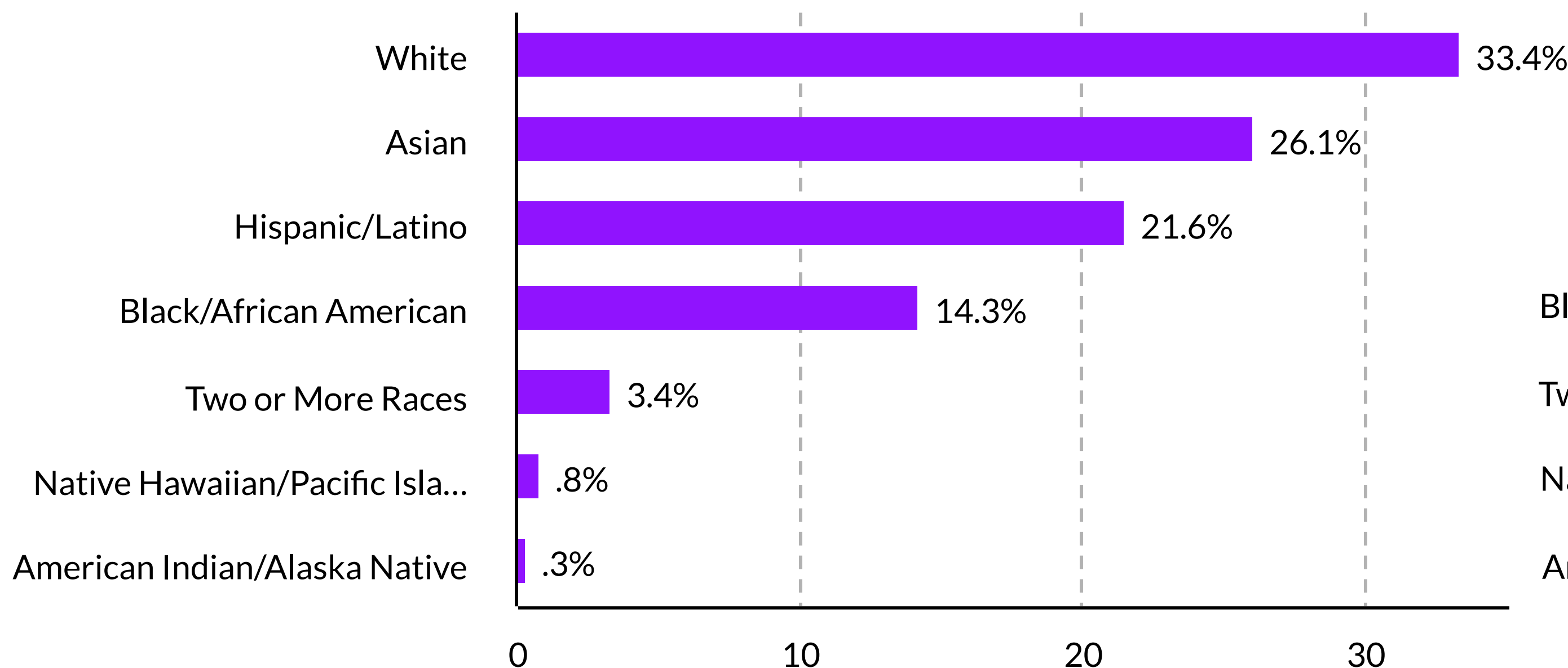

Total GRP (2020)

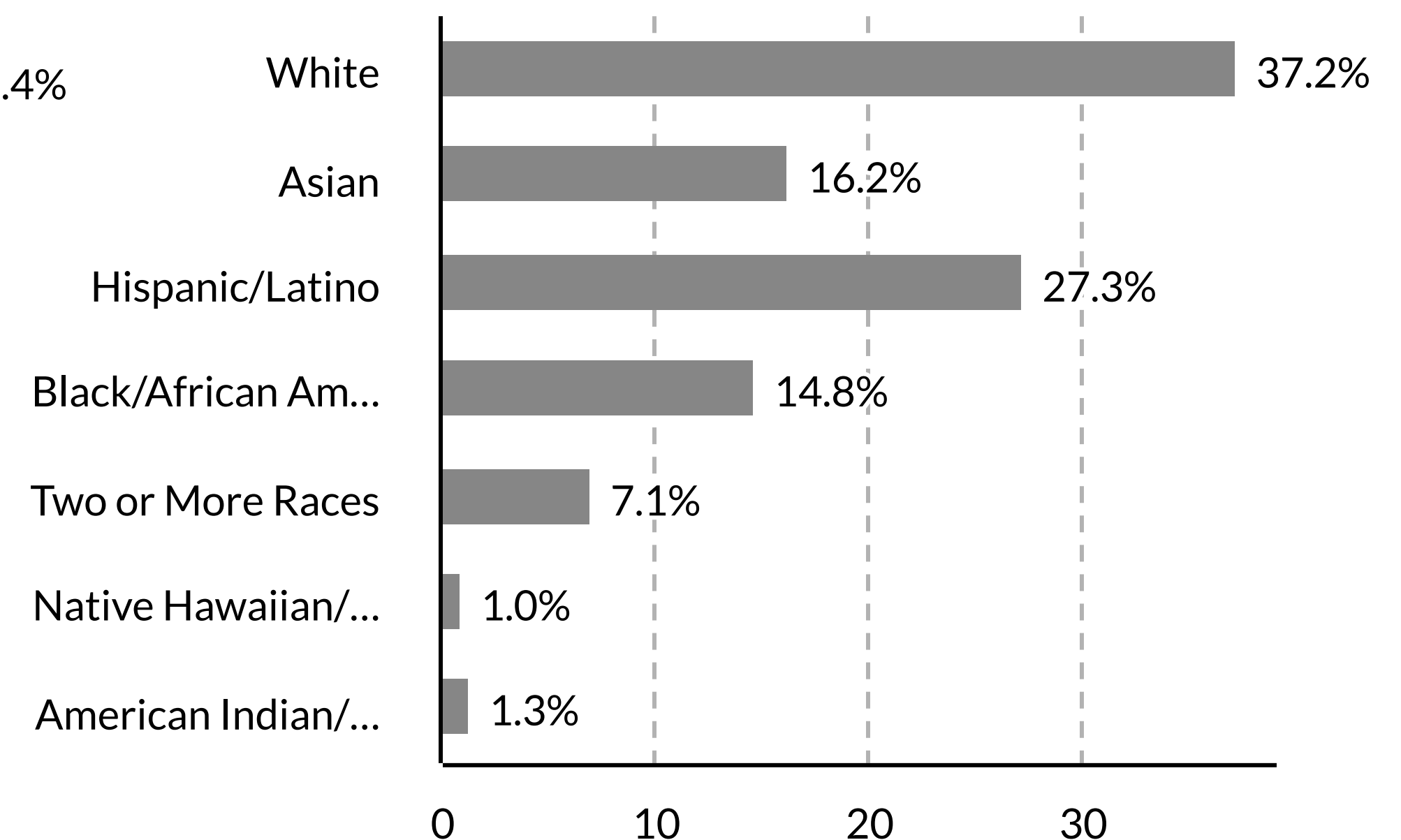

## Industry Race/Ethnicity Breakdown

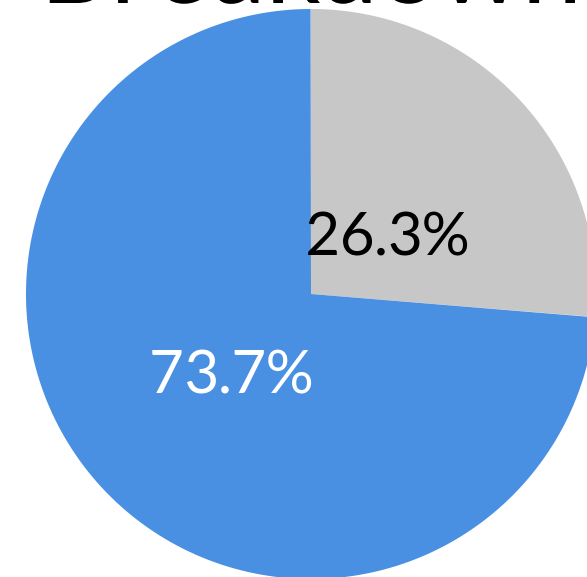

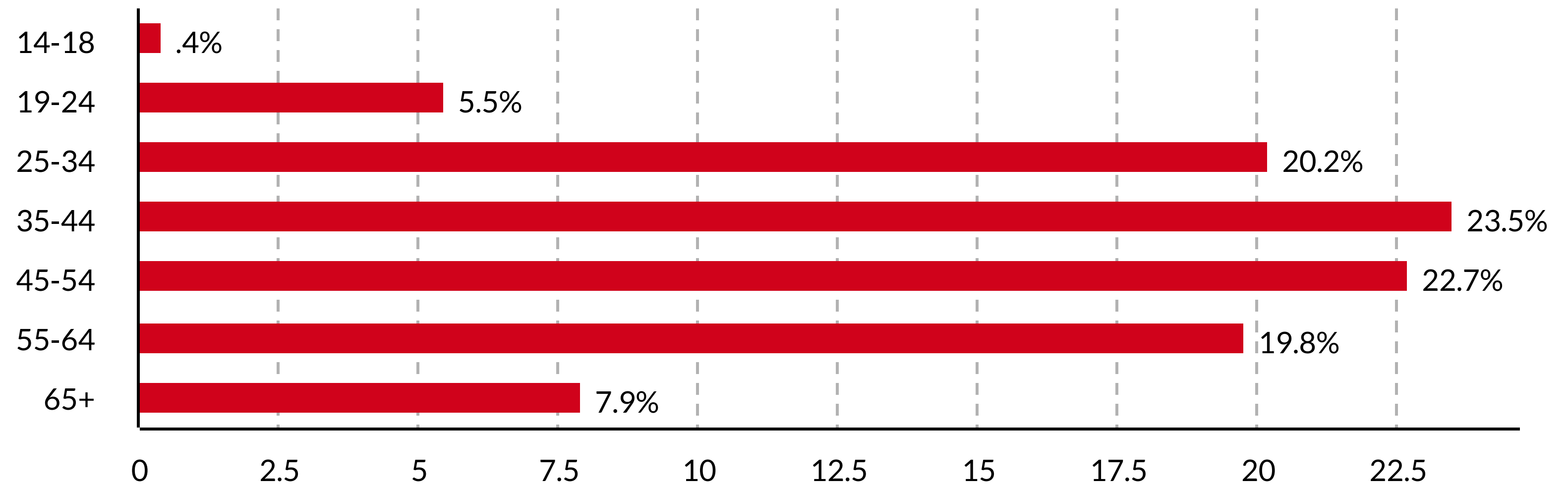
