Part A - The applicant:

- Does not attend any school; *and*
- Is between the Ages of 16 and 24; *and*
- Meets one or more of the criteria listed in section B1 or B2

Part B1 - The applicant *is low income* and meets one or more of the following criteria:

- Is the recipient of a secondary school diploma or its recognized equivalent *and* is either basic skills deficient *or* is an English language learner
- Requires additional assistance to enter or complete an educational program or secure and hold employment

Part B2 – The applicant *may or may not (does not have to) be low income* but meets one or more of the following criteria:

- Is subject to the criminal justice system (arrested / convicted of a crime)
- Is disabled
- Is pregnant or parenting
- Is homeless
- Is a school dropout
- Is within the age of compulsory school attendance, but has not attended school for at least the most recent complete school year calendar quarter.
- Is a runaway
- Is in Foster care or has aged out of the foster care system.
- Is eligible for assistance under section 447 of the Social Security Act.
